COVID-19 Statement – 28th April 2020

Further to our previous notice, we are writing to advise you of Salt Separation Services plans for the near future.

For the last few weeks, we have had a skeleton staff dealing with spares orders and critical production in the workshop. Their efforts have been greatly appreciated during this challenging period.

Our priority, as always, is the health, safety and wellbeing of our staff, customers, supply chain and the wider community. Having reviewed and assessed our workplace and working practices, we have implemented measures to enable work to continue whilst following HM Government guidance with respect to Coronavirus.

We are introducing a staged return to work. This week, a small number of people have returned to complete some project work on the shop-floor and to help prepare the workplace for the following week, where more people will be returning to work. We have introduced a two-shift pattern of work to limit the number of employees in the workplace at any one time.

There will be an ongoing review of the effectiveness of the measures we have implemented as we gradually introduce further personnel back into the workplace.

Many of the office staff will be working from home in accordance with HM Government guidance.

Staff who are shielding for the 12 weeks period stipulated by HM Government will remain so.

We kindly ask that you please bear with us whilst we settle into this “new normal” way of working – we are doing all we can to limit the impact on delivery schedules.
